What is the WDJGA?

The Windsor & District Junior Golf Academy is a developmental junior golf program designed to create a network for children to learn to play golf, make friends and sample competition in a positive and supportive learning environment. Our programs provide the opportunity to develop skills, progress in golf and have fun while establishing a lifelong interest in the game.

Payment Types and NSF Cheques

The Academy accepts cash and cheques ONLY. Payment in full is required upon registration.

Please note that NSF or STOP PAYMENT cheques will result in a \$35.00 administration fee.

Registration

Registration forms are available at Ambassador Golf Club or online at www.kidsforegolf.ca. Registration is complete only when payment is received.

How will you confirm each golfer's Registration?

Your cancelled cheque is immediate confirmation that your child is enrolled in the program. We do not process payment until we have enough participants to hold a program. As well, the week before the program starts, we will email you a reminder to confirm the times and dates of the lessons. If you do not have an email address, we will contact you by phone.

How many children are in the lessons?

We believe in quality over quantity, so we limit each class to 8 - 10 participants. Subject to enrollment, the children will be grouped by similar abilities.

What if my child misses a class?

Unfortunately, due to scheduling differences and class size limits, missed classes cannot be made up.

What if my child has medical or other concerns?

Please let us know on the Registration form. Attach a separate sheet of paper if required. If your child uses an EpiPen or asthma rescue inhaler, please **advise us where it is stored in the event of an emergency.**

Class Cancellations

The Academy reserves the right to cancel a program due to insufficient Registration. Should we have to do so, we will strive to provide parents with as much notice as possible.
